City Council met in regular session on July 3, 2018. Mayor Demshar called the meeting to order at 7 p.m. Members present included Councilors Tim Savage, Rose Mosbey, Billy Shalata, David Tate, Glennise Wendorf, Rob Zotti, David Halter and Mayor Demshar. Councilor Jason Armstrong was absent from the meeting. Department Heads present included Kara Beech, Matthew McBurnett, Dave Lansang, Paul Kauchich, Steve Horton, James Wamsley, Richard Beckwith, and Matthew Keslar (acting as Chief of Police). The pledge of allegiance was recited.

Approval of Revised Agenda

Moved by Councilor Mosbey, seconded by Councilor Wendorf to approve the revised agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of Minutes

Moved by Councilor Tate, seconded by Councilor Zotti to approve the Special City Council Meeting Minutes of June 7, 2018, and the City Council Meeting Minutes of June 19, 2018. Motion carried unanimously.

APPOINTMENTS

Board of Adjustment—Cross, Kayle, 1st Term; Manatos, Mary, 1st Term; West, Keaton, 1st Term

Moved by Councilor Wendorf, seconded by Councilor Mosbey to appoint Kayle Cross, Mary Manatos, and Keaton West, for a 1st term on the Board of Adjustment. Upon roll call the following voted in favor: Councilors Tate, Wendorf, Zotti, Halter, Savage, Mosbey, and Shalata. Motion carried unanimously.

PRESENTATIONS AND PROCLAMATIONS

Presentation: WyoRadio-Josh Henderson, Advertising for High School Sports Events

Mr. Henderson addressed the Council and informed them that he is now doing play-by-play announcing for Rock Springs High School sporting events as a representative of WyoRadio. This football season, WyoRadio will be offering live video streaming of Rock Springs High School football games. Mr. Henderson asked the Council to consider a 3 month commitment to sponsor the live video streaming, approximating \$1,200-\$1,400 per month for a 3 month contract, which will include commercial advertising, as well as logo placement on the "Tiger Crawl." Mr. Henderson will also be proposing a "Coach's Corner" weekly, which could provide additional commercial opportunities. Councilor Zotti expressed opposition to using public funds for such purposes. Mayor Demshar advised that Mr. Henderson visit him at City Hall to obtain a more specific estimate and discuss the contract details.

<u>Presentation: Wyoming Wildnerness Association—Shaleas Harrison, Migration Corridor/RS</u> <u>Planning Area</u>

Ms. Harrison informed the Council that her goal in this presentation is very explicit — which is to defer Oil and Gas Leases that the Bureau of Land Management will be selling this fall. The leases that she is referring to are located in the newly discovered Red Desert to Hoback Mule Deer Migration Corridor, the Northern Red Desert, and Adobe Town. All three areas contain rare species of animals and are very fragile ecosystems that would be destroyed with the new Oil and Gas Leases that are scheduled to be bid out in the fall. Ms. Harrison asked the Council to sign on to her letter to the Governor, which asks for these leases to be deferred. Councilor Savage asked what percentage and/or a count of leases she is asking to be deferred, from the total leases to be sold. Ms. Harrison replied that she is asking for less than 10% to be deferred, to protect these specific areas. Councilor Savage agreed to sign on to the letter. Mayor Demshar asked Ms. Harrison to e-mail the letter to the Council, so it can be reviewed and consideration be taken before signing.

Mayor Demshar acknowledged the receipt of the Parks & Recreation Advisory Board Meeting Minutes of May 10, 2018.

Councilor Shalata asked Fire Chief James Wamsley to say a few words regarding fire safety for the upcoming Fourth of July holiday. Chief Wamsley asked citizens to keep fireworks usage to a minimum and to call 911 as soon as possible if a fire is suspected. He stated that fireworks are illegal in Rock Springs city limits, on public lands, and only allowed within Sweetwater County if they are on private property with permission of the property owner.

Mayor Demshar recognized DeBernardi's Construction Company, Inc. for their contributions to the gathering area on the corner of M Street and North Front Street, including gazebos, landscaping, and concrete. A plaque will be given to DeBernardi's at City Hall next week.

Moved by Councilor Tate, seconded by Councilor Halter to approve the Council Committee and Board Reports and place them on file. Motion carried unanimously.



A RESOLUTION TO GRANT A RIGHT-OF-WAY CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE EASEMENT TO ROCKY MOUNTAIN POWER, AN UNINCORPORATED DIVISION OF PACIFICORP, AND AUTHORIZING CARL R. DEMSHAR, JR., AS MAYOR OF THE CITY OF ROCK SPRINGS, WYOMING, AND MATTHEW L. MCBURNETT, AS CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF ROCK SPRINGS, WYOMING, TO EXECUTE SAID RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT ON BEHALF OF SAID CITY.

WHEREAS, Rocky Mountain Power has requested a Right-of-Way Easement across real property owned by the City, 15 feet in width and 145 feet in length, for the construction, operation and maintenance of electric power transmission, distribution and communication lines; and,

If the application does not conform to the submittal requirements, the application will be deemed as incomplete, the subdivider will be notified and the application will be returned.
- Agency Review After it is determined that a complete Final Plat submittal has been made, the Planning Department shall refer material to appropriate agencies for review and comment (a utility review meeting will be held).
- At least seven (7) days prior to the Planning and Zoning Commission at which the plat is to be considered, the Planning Department shall notify the owners of subdivided and unplatted land within 200 feet of the boundaries of the proposed subdivision of the time and date of the meeting.
- The Planning and Zoning Commission shall review the Final Plat in a public meeting. In reviewing the Final Plat, the Commission shall consider oral or written statements from the applicant, the public, City staff, and the Commission. The Commission may recommend approval, conditional approval, disapproval or may table the Final Plat.
- Approval of the Final Plat by the Planning and Zoning Commission shall remain effective for 12 calendar months. A Final Plat which has not received approval of the City Council within 12 calendar months following Planning and Zoning Commission approval shall be subject to the requirements of Section 16-502 (Preliminary Plat). The subdivider may apply in writing for, and the Commission may, for cause shown, grant a six month extension to the 12 month period.
- Upon being notified of the comments and any necessary approvals of reviewing agencies, the Planning Department shall forward the Final Plat, comments and approvals of reviewing agencies, pertinent supporting materials, and the recommendations of the Planning Commission to the City Council. <u>Incomplete Pinal Plats for which necessary approvals have not been secured shall not be forwarded to Council for action.</u>
- City Council Action The City Council shall either approve the Final Plat or disapprove the Final Plat and notify the subdivider of the conditions to be met to gain approval. If a disapproved Final Plat is modified and resubmitted to the City Council at a later date for their consideration, the Council may require the concurrent submittal of an updated ownership and encumbrance report or title opinion.
- Filing With County Clerk Upon approval by the City Council of the Final Plat, the subdivider shall submit payment for the recording fee to the Planning Department within sixty (60) days after approval of the Final Plat by the City Council. The Planning Department shall transmit the subdivider's recording fee and the duly approved and executed Final Plat to the County Clerk and Recorder for the filling of the Final Plat among the official records of the County.
- Alternate Approval Procedure As an alternate procedure and at the request of the subdivider, the City Council may approve a Final Plat and instruct the Planning Department to withhold the approved Final Plat from recording for a period of time to allow the subdivider to install all of the required public improvements according to the plans and specifications approved by the City Engineer. (NOTE: Since the plat will not be recorded, lots cannot be sold). This procedure, when approved by the Council, shall be in lieu of the guarantees for installation or improvements as set forth in Section 16-503 (G).9. of the Subdivision Ordinance. NOTE: If decided to petition the City Council to accept the "Alternate Approval Procedure" in lieu of the financial guarantee, contact the City Planning Department to receive a sample agreement. Be advised that the City Council has the right to refuse the Alternate Approval Procedure and has the right to require the financial guarantee as required in Section 16-503.G.(9).
 - O An executed standard contract as approved by the City Attorney regarding installation of improvements shall be submitted with the Final Plat. (Contact the Planning Department for a sample contract)
 - O The contract shall require that all improvements be completed no later than twelve (12) months from the date the Final Plat was approved by the City Council.
 - O The subdivider may apply in writing for, and the Council may, for cause shown, by Resolution grant a six (6) month extension to the twelve (12) month period.
 - After all improvements are inspected and approved by the Governing Body, by resolution, the Plat shall be recorded by the
 Department in accordance with Section 16-503(J), and the sale of lots may proceed according to the approved and
 recorded plat.
 - O Building permits for structures will not be issued within the subdivision until the plat is recorded and the requirements of Section 16-808 are met.
 - O If after receiving approval of the alternate approval procedure the subdivider chooses to submit a Financial Guarantee in accordance with Section 16-503.G.(9), the subdivider shall provide the City Engineer an Engineer's Cost Estimate of the remaining improvements.
 - After approval of the cost estimate by the City Engineer, the Financial Guarantee shall be submitted and approved by the Governing Body of the City of Rock Springs by resolution and the filling of the plat shall proceed as specified in Section 16-503.J.

H. CONSTRUCTION / IMPROVEMENT CHECKLIST:

The following checklist is provided to make the property owner / developer / engineer aware of the City's Subdivision Ordinance pertaining to subdivision improvements and the process for acceptance of such Improvements: Release of Financial Guarantee - As improvements are completed, inspected and approved by the City Engineer, the subdivider may apply to the City for a release of a proportionate part of any collateral deposited with the City. Design by Professional Engineer - All public improvements must be designed by a professional engineer. licensed to do such work in the State of Wyoming. On Site Representative - The developer shall designate, in writing, the name of the agent who shall be available at all times during construction progress and who shall not be replaced without a written notice to the City Engineer. The agent will be the developer's representative at the site and shall have the authority to act on the developer's behalf. Installation of Improvements - The subdivider shall install the following improvements in a timely manner and in accordance with plans, specifications, and data as approved by the City Engineer. Refer to Section 16-805 of the Rock Springs Subdivision Ordinance for installation criteria of the water main system, fire hydrants, storm drainage system, sanitary sewer system, streets (including transportation plan streets), street grading and surfacing, street lights, streets name signs and traffic control signs, utilities and other facilities and improvements. Monuments: The owner and subdivider shall, at his expense, install monuments at all subdivision boundary corners which shall be marked with two (2) inch diameter brass caps. These caps may be set in concrete or be affixed to thirty (30) inch lengths of galvanized pipe and shall be properly marked for identification as to location, shall carry the true elevation, shall be referenced if subject to destruction, and again shall show the proper identification and license of the certifying surveyor. O Perimeter ties shall be shown to all Section, Quarter Section and Sixteenth Section Lines. Block and lot corners, Points of Tangency and Points of Curve of all curves shall be marked by a distinctive survey corner marker. Where section lines and quarter section lines intersect the center line of any street, reference shall be given to the nearest section corner or quarter corner. The placement of all monuments shall be under the supervision of the Director of Engineering and Operations, and the owner may be required to pay a reasonable charge for the inspection service. As-Built Plans -Prior to the approval and acceptance of any completed improvements, as-bullt plans must be submitted to the City Engineer in accordance with Section 16-806 of the Rock Springs Subdivision Ordinance. Acceptance of Improvements - At any time after the completion of construction of public streets and their inspection by the Director of Engineering and Operations, the subdivider may request that the City accept maintenance of the streets. The City Council may accept maintenance of streets, sewers, and rights-of-way if all work is in compliance with City specifications and requirements at the time of acceptance providing the developer presents to the City a one year warranty on the construction. (This requires a resolution by the City Council) Issuance of Building Permits - Building Permits may be Issued for lots within a subdivision only after final plat approval is granted by the City Council and water and sewer service is stubbed to the lots. Occupancy permits for buildings shall not be issued until the installation of subdivision improvements is completed (including acceptance of the improvements as outlined above), which shall include curb, guller, sidewalk and paving. NOTE: Building Permits will not be issued for any structure within a subdivision following the Alternate Approval Procedure. Compliance with Drainage Plans - Subdivision drainage plans, and individual lot drainage plans, must be complied with. Upon completion of final subdivision grading and prior to building permits being issued, a certified topographic survey verifying final grades with proposed grades shall be submitted. Spot elevations shall be given for all inverts, low points and flowing entry and exit points. Plot plans for Building Permits must show, and be consistent with, the drainage plan approved for the lot. Individual lot drainage plans included on the Preliminary Plat shall also be included on the Final Plat Construction Plans. Occupancy Permits for buildings shall not be Issued until a certified survey showing final grading has been submitted and approved by the City. (See Section 16-808 for additional requirements.) Lot drainage must remain consistent with the drainage plan approved for the lot.

- E. Assist in the development and promotion of events and activities designed to attract tourists to our areas as a destination. Working not only with the City of Rock Springs, but other partners as determined by the Chamber Board of Directors.
- F. The Rock Springs Chamber will provide written or oral updates to the City Council on a quarterly basis. The director will also meet monthly with the City of Rock Springs Mayor.

- B. Maintain an updated inventory which include commercial and industrial real estate listings on G.I.S. site.
- C. Provide access to all partners which includes database, website, G.I.S. listings and toolkit resources.
- D. Work to secure grants when feasible to implement new Economic Development programs.
- E. Include City/County liaison in development of Strategic Planning and Recruitment.
- F. Accept the City/County Liaison as a full voting member of the SEDC.
- G. Pursue educational and certification opportunities for the Business Development Manager.
- H. Business Development Manager will provide written or oral reports to partners on a quarterly basis.
- I. SEDC will respond to business leads and inquires in a timely manner.
- J. SEDC will refer new business opportunities to an appropriate location within Sweetwater County.
- K. SEDC will strive to implement Business Expansion and Retention programs for all business in Sweetwater County.
- L. SiteSeer Retail Recruitment Partnership

To accomplish these deliverables, the Business Development Manager will act as the central point of contact for business inquiries, relocation, and startup. The Business Development Manager will work with an advisory board consisting of representatives from each of the SEDC partner entities.
