## 2018 Primary election sign regulations for Rock Springs.



*With the upcoming primary election, here are some important reminders:*

- Total sign area per lot or parcel shall not exceed forty (40) square feet.
- Signs located within forty (40) feet of a street intersection shall not exceed 30 inches in height.
- NO sign shall project beyond the property line of the parcel upon which it is erected.

## Primary Election Signs

Friday, June 22<sup>nd</sup> - Signs may be erected

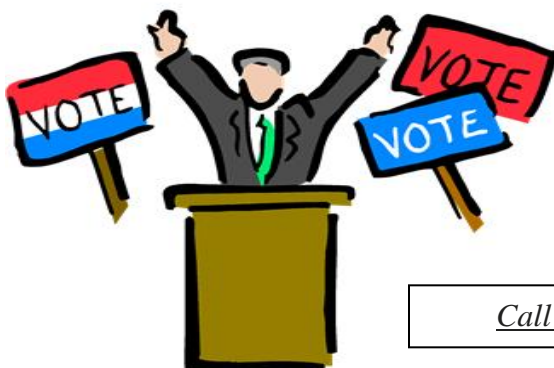
Friday, August 31<sup>st</sup> - Unsuccessful candidates must remove signs

- The display of signs shall be allowed in any zoning district and shall be limited to a period of sixty (60) days preceding any Primary, General, or Special Election to which they refer.

- NO signs shall be located in any public street right-of-way, this includes power poles. Any sign located in a public street right-of-way, **will be removed** by the City of Rock Springs.

- Signs must be located on private property, which you must obtain permission from the landowner.
- Signs may be freestanding, single, or double faced and may be parallel or perpendicular to the street.
