Written Test Information

Congratulations on deciding to apply to become a Police Officer! Most applicants are required to pass a written exam that conforms to the Wyoming Peace Officers Standards and Training (POST) criteria. If you are already POST certified in the United States, you are not required to take the written exam.

The test consists of four sections that will measure the applicant's basic math, reading comprehension, grammar and writing. Each applicant must have a minimum score of 70% in each section with an overall average of 75% to be considered passing. The written exam is held during testing. An applicant must first pass the physical fitness portion of the testing in order to be eligible to take the written exam.
