



# Employment Opportunities

The City is made up of a diverse workforce. There are employment opportunities for individuals seeking full-time, part-time and temporary employment. All open positions are advertised on the City's website at <http://www.rswy.net>, and select Employment under the Department tab. The Human Resources Department conducts hiring for:

- Police Department, including police officers, animal control, nuisance inspectors and administration
- Fire Department, including fire fighters and administration
- Public Services, including Planning and Zoning, Building Inspection, Vehicle Maintenance, Water Reclamation, and Main Street/URA
- Engineering and Operations, including Water, Streets, Facility Maintenance, Cemetery, and Engineering
- Parks and Recreation, including the Family Rec Center, Civic Center, Wataha Recreation Complex and Parks
- Administrative Services, including Finance, Water Administration, Housing, IT, Museum and administration
- Municipal Court support staff
- City Attorney support staff

The City of Rock Springs offers a great **benefit package** that includes:

- Health Plan inclusive of medical, dental and vision (monthly premiums start at \$134.29);
- Vacation (12 days), sick leave (12 days) and holiday pay (13 days);
- Wyoming Retirement Pension Plan 100% paid by the City along with 457B options
- Life insurance - \$25,000 paid by City with additional buy-up options
- Discounted passes to the White Mountain Golf Course and 2 indoor recreation facilities
- Wyoming has no state income tax



**Rock Springs** is located in southwest Wyoming at the strategic crossroads of Interstate 80 (the East-West corridor of historic transcontinental trails, railroads, pipelines and telecommunications) and US Highway 191 (the North-South corridor running from Mexico all the way to Canada and connecting Arches National Park, Moab, and Dinosaur National Monument to the Teton and Yellowstone National Parks). Rock Springs has a population of 24,520 and Sweetwater County's population totals 44,175.



Historically we are the "Gateway to the West" and our magnificent high desert scenery, as well as our fishing and hunting, are the equal of any in America. These and our unique off-road and water recreation resources, and impressive wildlife, are making Rock Springs a recreation destination unique among the many in Wyoming. Historic Flaming Gorge, the unusual Killpecker Sand Dunes and the gorgeous Red Desert are all right in our back yard.

Western Wyoming Community College, an unusual architectural structure sitting on the plateau overlooking the town, is an accredited two-year college offering A.A. and A.A.S. Degrees and in cooperation with area universities, Bachelor and Masters Degrees. The extensive adult education programs, teleconferencing capabilities, a stunning Natural History Museum and Dinosaur Exhibit also enrich the community.

Rock Springs' characteristics and its quality of life are phenomenal but what truly defines our city is its people. Ultimately, it is people who make a community, and we celebrate the immigrants from all over the globe who have blended to make wonderful neighborhoods in this great small city.
