Subject: Marijuana Odor Leads to One Arrest

Chief Pacheco announces that:

On September 16, 2015 at approximately 11:02 a.m. dispatch received a call concerning the odor of Marijuana on the second floor of the Super 8 Motel, located at 88 Westland Way in Rock Springs.

Officers and a Detective from the Rock Springs Police Department's Street Crimes Unit responded to the scene and verified that there was in fact the odor of Marijuana on the second floor. Through the investigation, it was determined that the odor was coming from room #208.

Contact was then made with the occupant of the room, who was identified as Gary Keller, 60 of Sacramento California. Officers discovered that Keller was in possession of Marijuana and that it had just been purchased in Colorado. Investigation revealed that he also had candy that contained THC, the active ingredient in Marijuana, which was also purchased in Colorado.

Keller was subsequently placed under arrest for misdemeanor possession of Marijuana and was transported to the Sweetwater County Jail where he was issued a summons for the offense.

All persons are presumed innocent until proven guilty.
