Proclamation: Purple Heart City

Mayor Demshar read a proclamation declaring the City of Rock Springs as a Purple Heart City, as well as August 7, 2018, as Purple Heart Day. He encouraged the citizens of Rock Springs to participate by helping to remember and recognize veterans who are recipients of the Purple Heart Medal. Doug Uhrig, the past Commander at the American Legion, addressed the Council by naming Purple Heart recipients that are from our community. He thanked the Council for proclaiming Rock Springs as a Purple Heart City.

Proclamation: Gastroparesis Awareness Month

Mayor Demshar read a proclamation declaring the month of August, 2018, as Gastroparesis Awareness Month, and urged the citizens of Rock Springs to spread awareness of this chronic illness in the hopes of encouraging more research and treatment options for those who suffer from it.

Presentation: Sweetwater Aquatics Team - Ron DeFauw

Ron DeFauw, Sweetwater Aquatics Team Coach, informed the Council that in September of 2017, the Rock Springs and Green River Swim Clubs joined together to form the Sweetwater Aquatics Team, also known as SWAT. Recently, in the Summer State Championship, the SWAT beat Gillette, who had been the reigning champion for this event since 1982. The SWAT also beat Gillette in the Winter State Championship, where Gillette had dominated since 2001. Mr. DeFauw informed the Council that of the 39 youth swimmers who participated in the Summer State Championship, all of them scored points.
