Winter Simulator Co-Ed Tournaments

February Tournament Dates

- February 1-February 28 (Register Jan 18 until full)
- Format: Stroke play
- Course: TBA

April Tournament Dates

- April 1 –April 30 (Register March 15 until full)
- Format: Stroke Play
- Course: TBA

Details

- Register in person at the Rock Springs Civic Center
- \$30 per player entry fee (includes simulator fee)
 - \$20 sim fee \$10 goes to prize
 - \$15 per player for alternating shot tournament
 - Women and all Seniors will play from the yellow tees. Men from the white tees. Must be at least 15 to register.
- Stroke play rules
 - 16 players only allowed for stroke play. Must play in 2-some or greater. No more than a 4-some
 - Civic Center will take requests for pairings, or will pair randomly.
 - Must complete your full 18 holes at once.
 - Must finish by last day of the month
 - Anyone not finishing will be disqualified and forfeit their entry fee
- One 18 hole, total handicapped score
- Alternate play rules (if held)
 - Alternate shot will be average of both players' handicap.
 - 32 players (2 person team)
 - Mixed teams (1 male & 1 female or 1 male & 1 senior) will play from whites. Otherwise teams will play from appropriate tees for gender and age.
 - 18 hole stroke play alternating shot with mandatory alternating drives
 - Required to choose your own partner. Teams may select playing group to play with, or will be chosen randomly by Civic Center staff
- Tee time is required for tournament play. Please specify that it is for the tournament.
 - For your tournament round **only**, you may reserve a slot any time during the month once you have registered and paid.

Handicapping

- Handicap will be based on your current GHIN or best HONEST guess of average round score.
- In subsequent tournaments, handicap will be based on the last tournament score or an average of all the tournaments played on the simulator.

Score Reporting

- You are required to write your score down on a scorecard. When you arrive please stop at the front counter to ask an employee for the scorecard.
- At the end of the round, BEFORE YOU LEAVE, each player signs their scorecard, turns it in at the front and has playing partner(s) attest.

Simulator Exceptions

- No mulligans will be allowed ever, unless:
 - There was an obvious misread by simulator
 - This must be noted on physical scorecard and approved by playing partner(s)

Simulator Playing Hints

- Make sure the green dot on the screen says Ready
 - If you hover over the ball, or your hat does, on short shots it will not read
- For short game shots, try to visualize the distance rather than use your “feel” based on what you see on the screen. All the pertinent info is in the upper right hand corner.

Scoring/Format

- This will be a stroke play format
- We will play with TEN FOOT gimmie for all putts
- USGA rules of golf practiced where applicable.
- Scores will be posted weekly on our Facebook page and in the simulator room.

Things to be aware of

- We will set the environment to random, and the elevation will be set at the actual site of the course chosen.
- Only shots that the simulator actually reads will count. Please see hints section if the simulator does not read multiple shots.

Prizes

- Prizes
 - 1st – 65% of money awarded as WMGC pro-shop prize
 - 2nd 35% of money awarded as WMGC pro-shop prize
 - 3rd 2 hour of simulator time
- Actual prize amounts will be figured once final tournament fees have been tallied
