City Council met in regular session on December 15, 2020. Mayor Timothy A. Kaumo called the meeting to order at 7 p.m. Members present included Councilors Keaton West, Tim Savage, David Halter, Rob Zotti, Ryan Greene, Jeannie Demas, David Tate, and Billy Shalata. Department Heads present included Dwane Pacheco, Rick Beckwith, Jim Wamsley, Alex Visser for Matthew L. McBurnett, and Paul Kauchich. The pledge of allegiance was recited.

Mayor Kaumo took a moment to thank Councilors Tate, Shalata, and Greene for their service as City Councilors, as this will be their last meeting. A standing ovation was given. In the near future it is hoped that a reception or something special can be scheduled for outgoing Councilors. Councilor Shalata thanked the voters in his ward for their faith in him, and the Department Heads, staff, and citizens for their faith in him as well. It has been a pleasure for him to serve. He respects Rock Springs and believes that it is a wonderful place to live. With little funding it has been difficult, but Rock Springs will persevere and do the right thing. Mayor Kaumo stated that people don't recognize the strain that serving on the Governing Body puts on family members, thanking the family members of each outgoing Council member as well.

Approval of Minutes

Moved by Councilor Zotti, seconded by Councilor Shalata to approve the City Council Meeting Minutes of December 1, 2020. Motion carried unanimously.

APPOINTMENTS

Fire Civil Service Commission—Steve Harton, 4th Term

Moved by Councilor West, seconded by Councilor Greene to appoint Steve Harton to serve a fourth term on the Fire Civil Service Commission. Upon roll call the following voted in favor: Councilors West, Savage, Halter, Zotti, Greene, Demas, Tate, and Shalata. Motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

A Public Hearing to discuss the proposed changes to the Rock Springs Housing Authority's Admissions & Continued Occupancy Policy (ACOP) to conform to the Department of Housing and Urban Development regulations (Resolution #2020-193)

A Public Hearing to discuss the flat rental amount for each public housing unit which complies with the requirement that all flat rents be set at no less than 80% of the applicable Fair Market Rent (FMR) adjusted, to account for reasonable utility costs (Resolution #2020-194)

A Public Hearing to discuss the proposed changes to the Administrative Plan for the Section 8 Voucher Program (Resolution #2020-195)

PETITIONS

Derek Van Brunt stated that an issue has recently come up regarding what is going on in this City, County and State. He has served in the military. Just because the public is told to do something, does not mean that it is lawful. The Chief of Police for the City of Rock Springs is enforcing an unlawful order issued by the Governor of the State of Wyoming. He quoted the 9th Amendment of the United States Constitution. Medical choices are a very basic right. Citizens are also given a right to contract, which indicates a right not to contract as well. As Council Members, it is their duty and solemn oath to uphold both the State and Federal Constitutions. If someone can issue a mandate without so much as a vote or legislation, perjury has been committed. The City is open to lawsuit and is liable for violation of civil rights. Income is being denied. Mayor Kaumo asked whether a copy of the documentation given to him was given to Governor Gordon. Mr. Van Brunt stated that it will be served to Governor Gordon with a Summons. Mr. Van Brunt believes that when the Police Chief calls to threaten establishments, it is a disgrace. Just because something is passed, does not mean it is lawful or enforceable. Case law was cited. He has spent 10 years studying law, and learned things that were not taught in law school. He hopes that people take the time to address this issue. Councilor Shalata thanked Mr. Van Brunt for his military service.

Justin Hilton hailed Hitler, Governor Gordon and Mayor Kaumo for bypassing the Constitution of the United States in the name of science. Instead of finding tangible solutions to these trying times, Mayor Kaumo and Governor Gordon chose tyranny instead. He called for the resignation of Mayor Kaumo and Chief Pacheco. Mr. Hilton stated that Chief Pacheco made a public statement regarding not knowing much about the Constitution. As for the City Council, he urges them to do what is right for the people of this community and upholding the rights preserved by the Constitution. It was not written for collectivism, but for individuals. He urged the Governing Body to remember what is written in the Constitution. There are so many ways that the citizens can exercise their rights, one is what is being done tonight, grieving to the Governing Body. There are many patriots in this town and they are sick of their rights being violated.

Dustin Aragon stated that he has been a resident of this City and State for 45 years. He is here to discuss the mandates that have been enacted by the Governor of Wyoming and are being upheld by City Officials. Article 1, Section 38 of the State of Wyoming Constitution reads that the people are to make their own medical decisions and that government infringement is not allowed. The draconian orders from the State Government are fueled by fear and explained by science. He asked whether the City of Rock Springs is willing to uphold an order that is not bulletproof. Mr. Aragon quoted Chief Pacheco in his public statement regarding serving patrons between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Mayor Kaumo stated that the Governing Body appreciates the comments presented this evening. He added that the City of Rock Springs is forced to comply with a mandate that comes down from the State. The City would never want to see businesses suffer. The Orders are discussed

internally and common sense solutions are constantly being offered. He is a business owner and many of the Governing Body members are also business owners. If businesses fail, sales tax fails and the City also suffers. Mayor Kaumo encouraged petitioners to speak to County and State officials, as the City is at the bottom of the totem pole. From a common sense point of view, there is no one on this bench that does not understand and support constitutional rights. He encouraged petitioners to make these comments known at the County and State level. On December 22, 2020, at 5:30 p.m. a Public Meeting will be held to discuss some of these issues, particularly face coverings, via Zoom. The Governing Body, as elected officials, want to understand concerns and make educated decisions moving forward. It is sad to see how much hate is in our lives, as threats have been made to Mayor Kaumo’s life, family members, as well as Chief Pacheco. The City’s decision has also been based on common sense. Councilor Zotti clarified that the meeting on December 22, 2020 is by Zoom, and Mayor Kaumo confirmed.
