The pledge of allegiance was recited.

### **Approval of Minutes**

### **PETITIONS**

Justin Hilton, citizen, stated that two years ago, Police Chief Dwane Pacheco infringed on a man’s first amendment right. He is now running for sheriff, and Mr. Hilton wanted to bring this to light. He does not believe that Mr. Pacheco would adhere to the Constitution. He asked Mayor Kaumo where he sits when contracts are approved, specifically relating to the bidding process. He asked Mayor Kaumo to confirm that he works for JFC Engineering, which is did. Mr. Hilton inquired as to how the bidding process was handled and whether Mayor Kaumo participated in that. Mayor Kaumo stated that all bids are handled through staff, and he has no involvement in the bidding process. He explained the process for bids. Mr. Hilton stated that with gas prices and food prices increasing so much, it makes sense to allow citizens to have chickens. He would rather live in a sustainable community. The people do not see compassion or empathy from the City Council regarding this subject. Mayor Kaumo stated that the reason

ordinances are created is to provide for the common interest, and that includes paying attention to comments from all of their constituency, not just those in support or not in support. They took the time to listen to the people from their wards to see what the majority felt with regard to allowing chickens within city limits. The silent majority did contact their councilors and helped to formulate a direction forward. Mr. Hilton added that the people are able to elect one law enforcement official throughout the county. He wants people to remember that there was a time where masks were mandated, which provided an opportunity for citizens to be arrested or fined for refusing to wear a mask.
